Clean Technology: Funding for Agriculture

A new pilot program will help farmers adopt clean technologies and implement on-farm projects that improve energy efficiency, generate renewable energy, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and lower energy costs. The [PEI Agriculture Energy Systems Pilot Program](#) (PEI AgESP) is a one-year pilot with possibility of extension.
