Employers: *Canada Summer Jobs - Wage Subsidies*

Applications are now open for the Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) wage subsidy program. The deadline to apply is midnight December 11, 2025.

Private sector, public sector and not-for-profit employers are eligible to apply.

CSJ will cover 100% of student wages for Not-for-Profit employers, and 50% of wages for private sector and public sector employers. Find details and apply [HERE](#).
